



## **Plan for parents and coaches at rink**

- All members taking part in club activities must self-screen in accordance with current public health guidelines before each training session
- Members will enter the facility by the front sliding doors, wearing a mask, staying 6 ft apart
- Members will exit the facility by the side doors of the rink
- Before entering the facility, members will be asked Skate Ontario health questions, have temperature taken and confirm contact information. Hand sanitizer will be provided
- Once inside the facility there will be signs and arrows directing people where to go. Only 1 parent is allowed in with a skater, no siblings.
- Skaters must keep masks on until they enter the ice
- Skaters must arrive at the arena in their skating clothes as change rooms may not be open. Skaters may only bring skates, helmet, gloves, water bottles and a mask worn properly. No big bags allowed
- Skaters are not required to wear a mask on the ice but must be wearing gloves to enter the ice. Borrowing gloves is not permitted. Skaters must have mask on before leaving the ice.
- Skaters are required to maintain a physical distance of at least 2 meters from any other person during the session.
- Skaters must use individual water bottles, tissue box during training sessions and must have their own closed containers for disposing of used personal items such as tissues (ie. ziplock bag)
- No skaters are to skate at multiple locations on the same day for all skaters and coach safety

Skaters must follow physical distancing protocols and remain at least 2m apart from any other individual while waiting to enter and exit the ice. There will be a separate entry and exit door marked with signs. At the end of the session, skaters will have 5 minutes to get changed and leave through the assigned doors at the Arena. There will be no re-entry at this point. Everyone must leave and will not be allowed back in these doors, as we will be cleaning to get ready for the next session.



At the end of the session **all** coaches will be cleaning all surfaces touched by skaters (boards, benches, doors, etc.) to help rink staff. We will have a schedule in place to say who does what on that day. All surfaces will be sprayed down and wiped. Coaches will have gloves provided and will clean with a spray. All staff need to participate when it comes to cleaning. We will supply gloves and cleaning spray and wipes and face shields for this to go over your current mask.

Only one door to our office at Elgin Barrow will be an entry and other exit. Only one person may be in the office at a time. We will have signage on the floor to keep 2m apart. We will have a plexi-glass barrier for protection of our administrator. Masks must be worn at all times in the office.
